## Carer Webinar on COVID-19 Vaccine

**Dear Carers,**

We have heard your concerns and queries about the COVID-19 vaccine rollout and have been lobbying with the National Carer Network on your behalf.

We can now advise that carers who are family members of a person with disability or elderly person may be able to get the COVID-19 vaccine as part of phase 1B.

To prove your eligibility, you can:

- Show carers documentation (e.g. proof of Carers Allowance)
- Fill in a *Phase 1B Declaration Form*.

Carers ACT cannot provide proof of eligibility.
